D: Conceptual clarity, lucidity, analytical criterion, capacity of observation. Wit for arranging complicated businesses.

R: Overwhelming passion, spiritual exaltation, quarrels, anger, bitterness, dissensions.

### **Chapter Three: ARCANUM III, THE EMPRESS**

PE: Knowledge of the occult.

PM: Ideation.

PF: Expansion of ideas and desires.

AT: "Your loom is weaving fabrics for your use and fabrics that you shall not use."

AA: Libra.

EG: Possible marriage; doubt is the woodworm of the soul; take advantage of the opportunity.

D: Certain marriage; durable sentimental union; reciprocal attraction; chaste kisses.

R: Distancing; affective coldness; bewilderment; letter of farewell.

## **Chapter Four: ARCANUM IV, THE EMPEROR**

PE: Manifestation of divine virtue.

PM: Final Solution.

PF: Realization of material things.

AT: "Bless the work of your hands, and put reason in the work of your thought."

AA: Scorpio.

EG: Intense affective contacts; control of the material; Dominion of oneself.

D: Eroticism; children; spiritual elevation; God.

R: Distancing; affective coldness; bewilderment; letter of farewell.

## **Chapter Five: ARCANUM V, THE HIEROPHANT**

PE: Manifestations of the Creator.

PM: Dominion of the passions.

PF: Control of the natural forces.

AT: "By the hearing of the ear I had heard of thee; but now my eye sees thee and my heart feels thee."

AA: Jupiter.

EG: Unexpected cooperation; help of equals or superiors; healthily oriented criterion.

D: Friendly and lavish hand; excellent diversion; satisfactory exchange; emotion before an encounter.

R: Retraction; delay; persistent nostalgias; isolation.

## **Chapter Six: ARCANUM VI, THE LOVERS**

PE: Instinctual knowledge.

PM: Abstinence and Gluttony, liberty and necessity, duty and right.

PF: Determination of state.

AT: "You give me works, Lord; but with them, fortitude."

AA: Venus.

EG: Do not let yourself be tempted; fix your positions; guide yourself by the spiritual.

D: Constant cavilations, dead-end alley, dejection, discomforts.

R: Envy lying in wait; importunate traps; treacherous confidences, deceitful friends, intriguers.

## **Chapter Seven: ARCANUM VII, THE CHARIOT**

PE: The spirit governs matter.

PM: Elimination of doubts and errors.

PF: Impulses and desires of overcoming.

AT: "When wisdom enters into your heart, and knowledge is pleasant to your soul, ask and it shall be given to you."

AA: Sagittarius.

EG: Triumph in what one proposes; your effort finds reward; agreeable vacations.

D: Advantageous operation; secure contract; accepted writings; concrete project.

R: Loss of a valuable object; useless lamentations; words of consolation from unknowns; trap in chance.

*AT: "When wisdom enters into your heart, and knowledge is pleasant to your soul, ask and it shall be given to you." AA: Sagittarius.*

AA: Aquarius.

EG: Affirm your discretion; do not comment your plans of purchase; meditate on the opportunity of your longing.

D: A word too many that discredits you; conflicting versions; absence of interior equilibrium; murmurings.

R: Priest, pastor, rabbi. Confidence in a secret that is not revealed; beneficial silence.

PE: Time and circumstances, artificers of perfection.

PM: The diverse processes of thought.

PF: Action and reaction.

AA: Uranus.

EG: The unusual faces fortune; farewell to an old friendship; bad mood and affliction. Do not despair.

D: A friend of the soul departs; old comrades knock at the door; letter announcing a gift; knowledge of a longed-for secret.

R: You lost the opportunity for now; do not attend that appointment; recognize the truth even if it pains you; anguishes.

D: Hasten the procedure, confirm your suspicions, do not enlarge capricious illusions.

R: Disillusion through forgetting; bury the ambition; your ambiguities do not benefit you.

EG: Ancient bitterness dissipates; detours do not fit when the heart must speak. Delight yourself in the beautiful, and you will perfect your soul.

D: Gather friendship and you will collect smiles; do not threaten flight; face the facts; kindness must be part of your own complacency.

R: Diminish your irritation; admonition near; perturbing friend harms the evening.

PE: Renovation of life.

PM: Inertia as function of movement.

PF: Lethargic, drowsiness, sleepwalking.

D: Pompousness does not suit you; do not condemn by analogy; love does not know of bombastic phrases, but of simple

surrender.

R: Quarrel over matter of interests, clash; extreme laziness that complicates everything.

PE: Union of the interior with the exterior.

PM: Reciprocal affections, association of ideas.

PF: Regulation of the relations of the sexes, equilibrium of the vital force.

AT: "Do not be like straw before the wind nor like wind before straw."

AA: Taurus.

EG: It is fitting to accord to things their just proportion; exaggeration destroys virtue; equilibrium is base of spiritual peace.

D: Help yourself by softening misunderstandings; concretize your purpose decidedly, but without harming your neighbor; hostility will yield.

R: Excesses of foods and drinks; the doctor calls; do not live in the extremes; extract from the apparently incoherent its fund

of truth.

R: Harmful affections, situations of violence; discords; malices.

## **Chapter Sixteen: ARCANUM XVI, THE TOWER**

PE: Affliction awakens virtue.

PM: The nullity of material values.

PF: Affliction, rigors, severity.

AT: "Light of dawn, light of midday, light of dusk: what matters is that it be light."

AA: Mars.

EG: The value of the temporal is exalted in function of the eternal; the perishable has vital importance in the becoming of things.

D: Reciprocity in love and in hatred, in indifference and in zeal, in betrayal and in loyalty.

R: Unforeseen accident; death; necessity; tempests.

## **Chapter Seventeen: ARCANUM XVII, THE STAR**

PE: Abnegation as fountain of life.

PM: Experience is light.

PF: Optimism, expectations, and charity.

AT: "Some men ask for signs to believe, and others ask for wisdom to act; but the hopeful heart has everything in its hope."

AA: Gemini.

EG: To await the future confidently is to pre-taste the immortality of existence. The magic of faith creates everything.

D: Intuition, illumination, births, gains.

R: Brief afflictions and brief satisfactions; vexations and reconciliations, privations, abandonments.

*AT: "Some men ask for signs to believe, and others ask for wisdom to act; but the hopeful heart has everything in its hope." AA: Gemini.*

PM: The negative is exponent of the positive.

PF: Manifestation of occult powers.

AT: "Let your charity be an inexhaustible granary."

AA: Cancer.

EG: Contrariety and deceit lurk; your hostility fosters enmities; care with treacherous flatteries.

D: Apparent triumphs and failures.

R: Inconstancy, ambushes, confusion, changes, long deliberations, unexpected impediments, tardy results.

## **Chapter Nineteen: ARCANUM XIX, THE SUN**

PE: The divine light is principle of knowledge.

PM: Motor intelligence.

PF: Materialization of ideas into acts.

AT: "Take the shield of your faith and advance with decided step, whether in favor of the wind or against all the winds."

AA: Leo.

EG: Joy is lodged with your temperance; consecrate yourself to your own and you shall not regret it; pure love is your armor.

D: Increase of power, benefits through one's own efforts, inheritances, clarity in what is desired.

R: Danger in employment, disputes over writings, misunderstanding through results.

## **Chapter Twenty: ARCANUM XX, JUDGMENT**

PE: Interior illumination.

PM: Revelation of genius.

PF: Harmonic correspondence between the moral and the material.

AT: "Flower in the apple tree, fruit in the vineyard, sowing in maturity."

AA: Moon.

EG: Old postponed aspirations concretize themselves; awaken to reality; laziness does not help to rise again.

D: Harmonic elections; fortunate initiatives, compensations, faithful friends.

R: Gains that are postponed; treacherous friends undermine success.

## **Chapter 21: ARCANUM XXI, THE WORLD**

PE: The power to manifest life in infinite forms.

PM: Supreme knowledge is blessedness.

PF: Inspiration, work, fitting reward.

AT: "The sun rises and the sun sets, and again returns to its place where it returns to be born."

AA: Sun.

EG: Success is within reach of your hand; in friendship is your greatest support; use the imagination; do not submit yourself to it.

D: Long life: inheritance, victories, aptitude to overcome obstacles.

R: Rivals who dispute affections, uncertain situation. Despot, tyrant, dominating relative.

## **Chapter 22: ARCANUM XXII, THE FOOL**

PE: Inscrutability of divine laws.

PM: Credulity, daring, and temerity are cause of ignorance, error, and danger.

PF: Imprudence, extravagance, delirium, vanity.

AT: "My soul does not enter into his secret, nor my ship into his port."

AA: Pluto.

EG: Do not take false steps through indiscretion; nor doubt much; you will self-limit; help your neighbor.

D: Peasant, end of some things and beginning of others.

R: Danger of isolation; obfuscation; perfidious gift; deceptive promise: disillusion.
